

Registering with the IRS to obtain Tax Transcripts Direct from the IRS

This is a service offered by the IRS; your use of this service is optional.

The Income Verification Express Service (IVES) program can be used by mortgage lenders to obtain tax information used to confirm the income of a borrower. The IRS provides tax return transcript, W-2 transcript and 1099 transcript information to a third party with the consent of the taxpayer (via 4506C), typically within 2-3 business days. A \$2.00 fee is imposed on each Non-Qualified Transcript and \$5.00 fee is imposed on each Qualified Transcript requested.

To participate in the IVES program, companies will need to 1) submit an application and 2) complete the e-Services registration process.

- ➤ To enroll in the IVES program, complete Form 13803, IVES Application Form.
- Registration is required for each employee assigned to receive electronic transcripts on the company's behalf. Registration is a one-time process where the user selects a username, password and PIN. Individuals will need to provide the following:
 - o full name
 - o email
 - o date of birth
 - o SSN
 - tax filing status
 - o current address
 - o account number from *one* financial account (i.e. credit card, student loan, mortgage or auto loan), which is used for identity verification.

After confirming the information provided, the IRS will mail a registration notice containing a confirmation number to the registrant's last known address of record.

Note: In summer 2022, the IRS will transition all e-Services tools from the legacy IRS system to a new sign-in system via a trusted technology provider, ID.me. You can prepare now and create an ID.me account. You'll be able to use your account across multiple IRS tools and at other government agencies that use ID.me, as well as e-Services applications starting in summer 2022.
